

Release Notes for WeLib, version 4.32.5

News in WeLib with BOOK-IT

Periodicals

- We have adjusted the catalog detail page for periodicals to mirror the way periodicals are catalogued in BOOK-IT.

News in WeLib with Quria

Catalogue

- If there are items still on the shelf in the library, we don't display the return date for the checked-out items anymore. We only show the return date if all items are checked out.

Catalogue search

- For our Norwegian customers: we have added a new search facet for searching genres.

Periodicals

- We have removed the duplicate information about issues for periodicals on the catalog detail page.

The start page

- If a patron uses the Contact form on the start page in WeLib, the username of that patron was included in the message that was sent to the library. As some customers use the Social Security Number as username, this presented a problem.
We have now replaced the username with first- and last name of the patron.

News in both WeLib (Aurora/BOOK-IT/Quria) and WeLib (stand-alone)

Catalogue

- We have reduced the size of the cover image on the catalog detail page, to make the view better.



- We have moved the heart symbol for “Likes” on the search result page to the right and added the word “Likes” beside the heart symbol and the number of likes.

Catalogue search

- We have changed the order in which the publication year is presented in the search facet “Publication year”. It is now showing the latest year first, and not the oldest as it was before.
- We have added a functionality to clear text in the search fields in the search facets. It is now possible to type in search words in a search facet and the remove that text using the “X” in the search field.
- We have updated the search result page in WeLib to increase accessibility and to give it a more modern look. The biggest changes are:
 - ✓ We have enlarged the information of number or hits
 - ✓ The sorting of the hitlist is moved to left of the page to be more in focus
 - ✓ The number of the hits is also moved to the left of the page to be more in focus.
 - ✓ The information about each search result has changed to mirror the catalog detail page
 - ✓ The headers of the search facets are changed to be less intrusive and to allow more space on the page

SSO (Single Sign-On)

- We have added a configuration setting for login via SSO: if the setting in WeLib has the SSO login in focus on the login page, the same setting will be implemented in the Self-Service Module. Please note! This is a configuration that needs to be ordered from the support department.

Bugfixes in WeLib (Aurora/BOOK-IT/Quria) and WeLib (stand-alone)

- Bugfix: we have corrected a bug in the sorting of search results in WeLib. If one chose to sort the search results on for example: “Best result” and then chose “News” the old choice of sorting was still in effect. This is no longer the case; the sorting now complies with the choice made by the user.
- Bugfix for Self-publishing: the resource type “E-book” was missing from the teacher role. This has now been corrected.
- Bugfix: when using WeLib on an iPhone, the search did not work well. We have corrected this issue now.

- For Aurora customers: we have corrected a bug that affected the roles in WeLib.
- For Quria customers: we have corrected a bug that allowed patrons to choose a pickup branch in WeLib, although that branch does not allow pickup of reservations.
- For Quria customers: we have solved a problem with visibility of issues of periodicals, if more than one branch has the same issue.
- For Quria customers: when a reserved item was checked in, in the Self-Service, the message on screen was incorrect. It said: This book belongs to another branch. Hand it to a member of staff.
The message now reads: The title is reserved.
